What a tremendously uplifting and exciting time to be part of the magic of Starlight Children's Foundation Canada. You're part of the magic, and we're delighted to share with you just a few highlights from our 2016 year.

Our philosophy of being a needs-based organization continued this year, seeing great feedback from our For Us By Us (FUBU) committee which highlighted our excellence in providing programs such as Great Escapes. Made up of Starlight children and parents from across the country, the FUBU committee provides us with periodic report cards on our services and suggests new programs that could benefit their families and others. In 2016, we created over **16,500 smiles and memories** for Starlight children and family members who attended events, while our costs related to delivering the programs decreased, marking excellent results with increased efficiencies.

Our recent work with the Ward + Robes campaign, in partnership with Rethink Marketing, saw our campaign video go viral with over **10 million** views to date. In addition we also saw exponential growth in our social media presence. Our fundraising events, such as our Gala, Drive for Smiles, and the Toys"R"Us Dash, collectively saw over **125 million media impressions**.

Thanks to you, our fundraising revenue grew once again. We welcomed new donors this year, and grew to have a presence in over **1400 retail locations**, becoming a true leader in retail fundraising campaigns.





Time together helped Évangéline and her family cope

Évangéline has stars in her eyes, and that's thanks to friends like you.

You see, Évangéline was born prematurely. Her mom, Séverine quickly found out that she had cytomegalovirus – a virus that can cause developmental delays, seizures and hearing loss. Séverine prepared herself and her family for the worst as Évangéline struggled to survive in those early days.

And yet, through multiple surgeries, pain, physical therapy and speech therapy, Évangéline smiled and showed a thirst for life.

"What touches me the most about Starlight is that you understood something that a lot of people won't see," says Séverine. "You understood that, when a member of the family suffers, it's the whole family who suffers."

Severine and her husband gave up their careers to care for Évangéline. But because of donors like you, they were able to get through the hardships, breathe deeply and enjoy magical moments together with Évangéline and their son Aaron.

"You have given us the right to be a true family for a day, an evening or a weekend. You gave us back the gentleness that we had lost at the birth of my daughter," says Severine.

Through Starlight's programs, Évangéline and her family had much needed time to bond and forget about treatments and surgeries for a while. From a fabulous Halloween party to belly laughs with clowns, these are moments that this family will hold close to their hearts forever.

And Severine knows how much Évangéline looks forward to those magical moments. In fact, they're written in big letters on their calendar at home.



Kayla keeps the magic going. This is her story in her own words:

There are days when the pain of my illness feels like it's swallowing me whole.

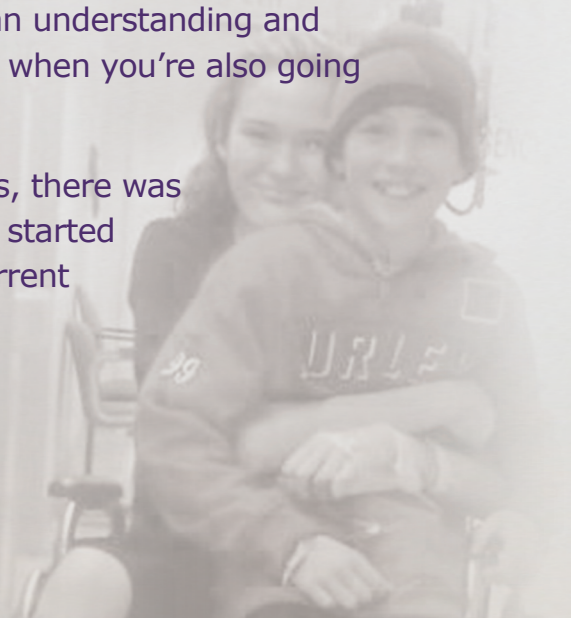
I've been living with debilitating health issues, including a rare digestive disorder called Superior Mesenteric Artery Syndrome, and Ehlers-Danlos Syndrome, which affects my body's tissue formation, for five years.

I'm now 21 and I still have days when I can't get out of bed. I've spent too many holidays in the hospital and have missed entire semesters of school because of my health issues.

As incredibly difficult and painful as it's been, I refuse to let my pain define me. And part of what's helped me get through it all was being a Starlight teen.

Four years ago, Starlight organized a weekend away for my family at Great Wolf Lodge. That's where I got to meet kids going through the same thing that I was. Since that weekend, I've made so many lifelong friends by going to Starlight events. There's an understanding and connection you have instantly with other kids when you're also going through huge health struggles.

I knew when I graduated from their programs, there was no way I could leave my Starlight family, so I started Team Wishes with my sister Courtney and current Starlight teen, Daniella.



We've been able to raise more than \$54,000 in three years, which has gone to Starlight to help fulfill wishes. And we haven't done it alone. My friend Emily, another Starlight graduate, and current Starlight teens Alexandra and our newest member Stephanie, have all helped. Even when down with pain and in and out of the hospital for treatments, they all put in the hard work and energy in the little spare time they have, so that they can help raise money to donate to Starlight.

While in-hospital, Starlight provides distraction, entertainment and relief from the stress and boredom of hospitalization in more than 160 healthcare facilities. When out-of-hospital, Starlight children benefit from programs that give them the chance to leave the "sick" behind, create special family memories and return home with a renewed sense of strength and hope.

In-Hospital Programs

Being in the hospital is not a lot of fun for anyone, but it's especially tough on kids. While doctors and nurses focus on treatments, Starlight is there to bring a much needed brightness and joy to distract from the seriousness of an illness.

Comfort Kits

Our Comfort Kits are themed bags designed for babies to teenagers and come packed with a range of age-appropriate entertainment and distraction activities.

Treasure Chests

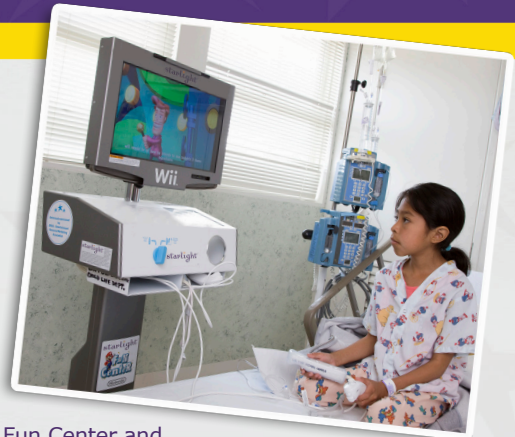
Starlight Treasure Chests are filled with a variety of small puzzles, games and toys that appeal to a variety of age groups.
